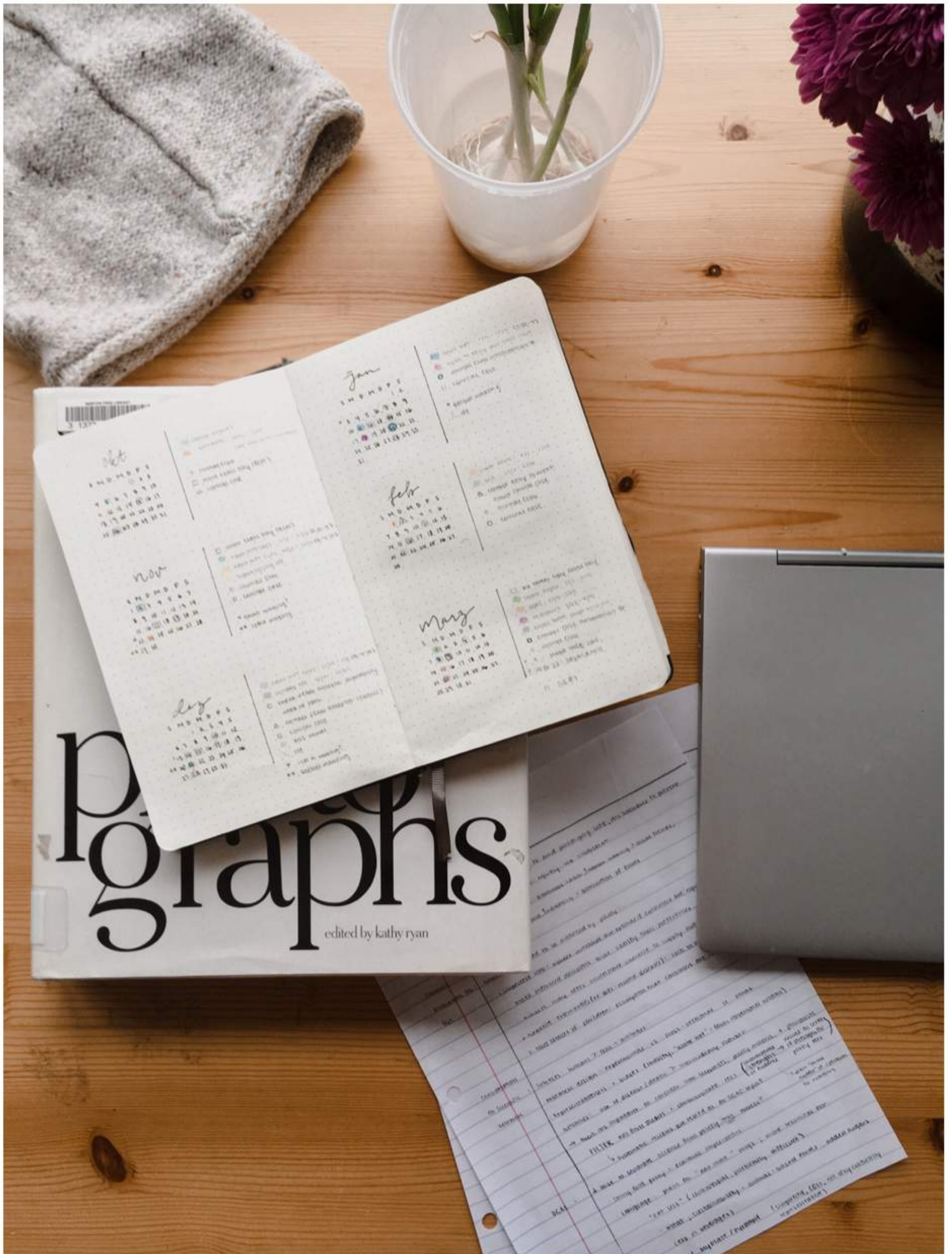
First week in cardiology in the books

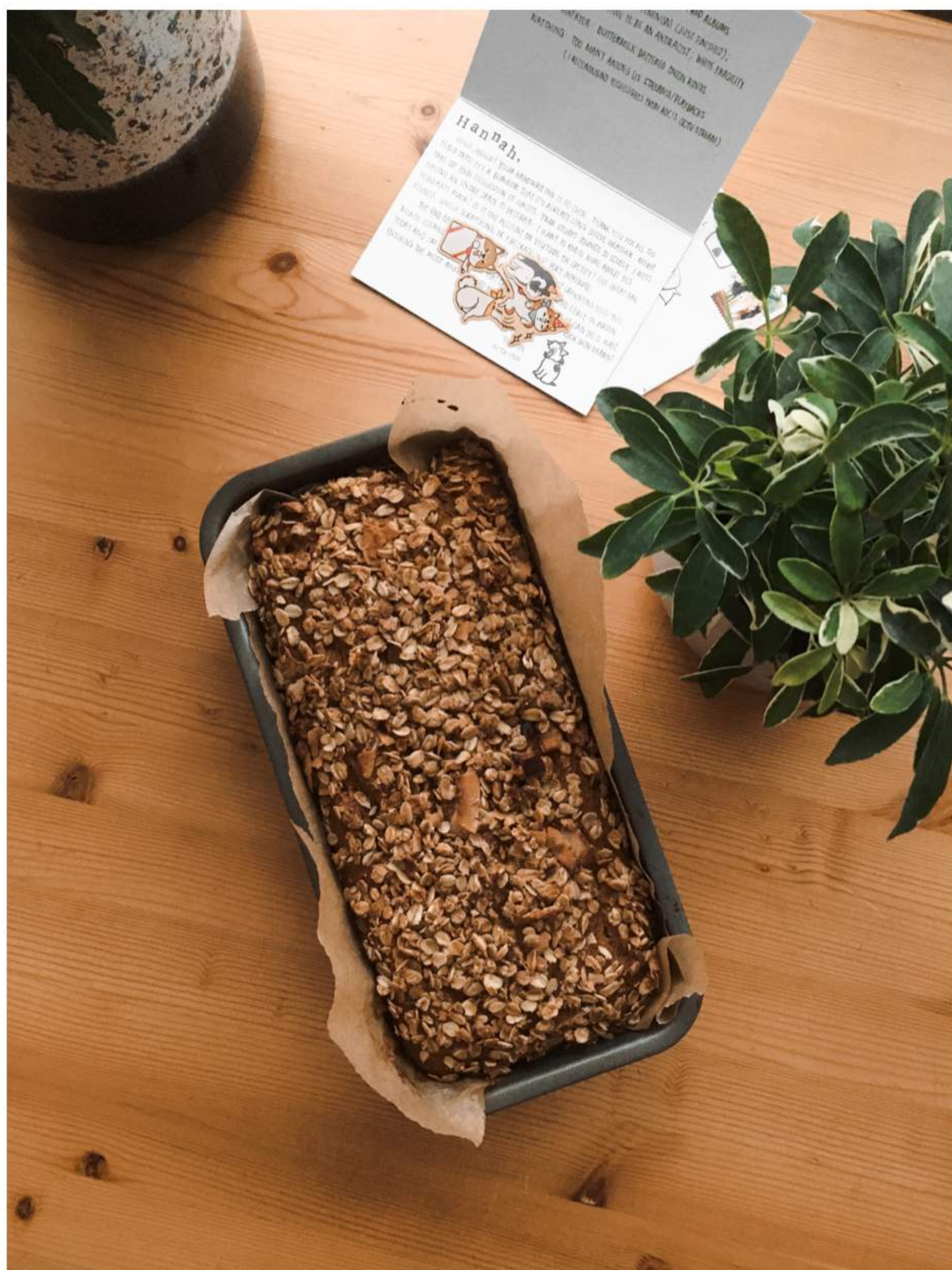

The next 6 months until graduation:

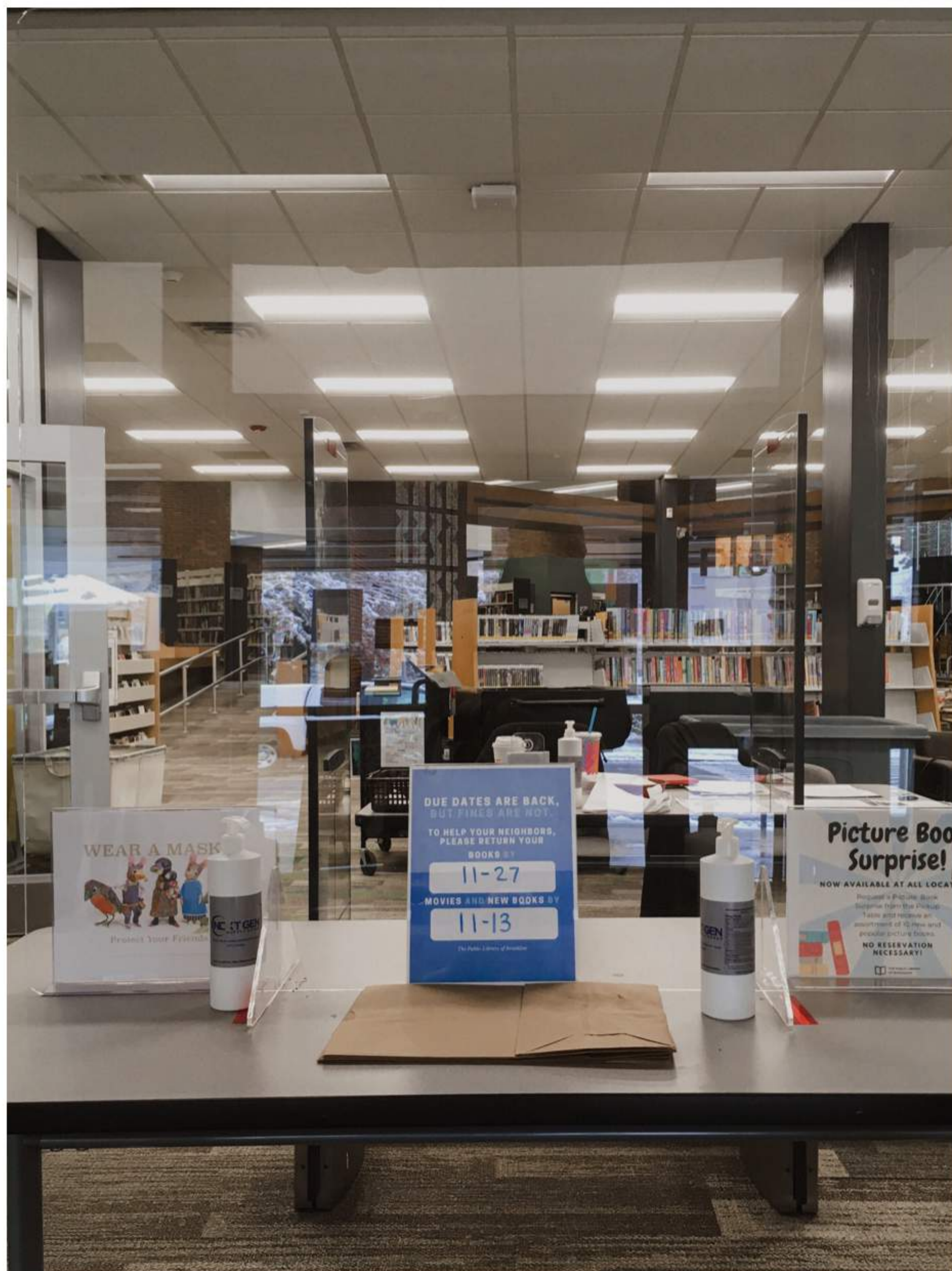
